

SCRAPPY BLOCK SWAP INSTRUCTIONS



Using a variety of left over fabric scraps create a cloth about 11x14" for each block heart. You will have extra but this gives you some flexibility.



You don't need a base fabric under. Start by sewing 2 scraps together. Press. Rotary cut a clean edge. It can be at an angle and add your next scrap or sewn together scraps. Continue to grow fabric.



Underside.

From this scrap fabric cut. 1) 5 inch square, 2) 3 inch squares and 1) rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$

From white fabric cut 1) 5 inch 2) 3 inch squares

Using the 3'' and 5'' squares of the white and the scrap fabric

Make 4) $2\frac{1}{2}''$ Half Square Triangles (HST) and 2) $4\frac{1}{2}''$ HST

Trim the HST to size.





Sew together as shown. The block will be 8½" square.

Make 6 to swap at the next meeting where we meet in or outdoors.
